

Directions to Camp Mary Mac

FROM DC, VIRGINIA, OR MARYLAND AREA AROUND THE DC BELTWAY

From I-495 Westbound from College Park, MD or Landover, MD areas, take the I-270 Extension Northbound Exit near the intersection of I-495 and Rt. 355 in the Bethesda-Rockville area.

From I-495 Eastbound from Virginia, enter Maryland across the American Legion Bridge and then take the I-270 Northbound Exit just after the intersection of I-495 and River Road.

- Go north on I-270 for about 31 miles to Frederick, MD. Stay to the right as you approach a large shopping mall complex and take the I-70 Westbound Exit towards Hagerstown, MD.
- Go west on I-70 for about 23 miles to Exit 29-Sharpsburg, MD. This is first exit past the Rt. 40 – Hagerstown exit.
- At the bottom of the Exit 29 – Sharpsburg ramp, turn left on to Sharpsburg Pike (Rt. 65). Go south on Rt. 65/Sharpsburg Pike for about 3.7 miles and cross through the Rt.68 intersection.
- Continue south on Rt. 65 about another 3.3 miles to the first right turn (Bakersville Road) after the Washington County Agricultural Education Center. Bakersville Road will be on the right just 0.5 miles past the driveway entrance to this large complex and its Rural Heritage Museum.
- Go north on Bakersville Road about 1.7 miles (crossing under a railroad overpass) and take a left on Sprecher Road. (There is a Camp Mary-Mac/Merry-Mac sign at the corner.)
- As soon as you turn left, you cross a small creek; stay on Sprecher Road about 0.4 miles to the intersection of Sprecher Road and Houser Road.
- **If checking-in for a camp**, bear right at the fork to stay on Sprecher Road to the main entrance of Camp Mary-Mac.
- **If attending the Corn Roast**, bear left at the fork to turn on to Houser Road. Go about 0.5 miles to the secondary entrance to Camp Mary-Mac (along side of a Farm House and Horse Pen). There is a sign at this entrance also.

FROM THE NORTHERN AND WESTERN MD AND PA AREAS

From I-81 South, take the Rt. 63/Rt. 68 South Exit at Williamsport, MD.

- Just after exiting on to Lappans Road (Rt. 63/68) off I-81, take a right on to Spielman Road (which becomes Route 63 south) to Downsville, MD.
- Continue on Spielman Road past Downsville, then bear right at a fork to turn on to Bakersville Road. Travel one mile on Bakersville Road and turn right on to Sprecher Road.
- As soon as you turn left, you cross a small creek; stay on Sprecher Road about 0.4 miles to the intersection of Sprecher Road and Houser Road.
- **If checking-in for a camp**, bear right to stay on Sprecher Road to the main entrance of Camp Mary-Mac.
- **If attending the Corn Roast**, bear left on to Houser Road for about 0.5 miles to the secondary entrance to Camp Mary-Mac (along side of a Farm House and Horse Pen). There is a sign at this entrance also.

FROM THE BALTIMORE AREA

From I-695 (North or South), take the I-70/Rt. 40 Westbound Exit towards Frederick, MD. Remain on I-70 West to Exit 29-Sharpsburg, MD. This is first exit past the Rt. 40 – Hagerstown exit.

- At the bottom of the Exit 29 – Sharpsburg ramp, turn left on to Sharpsburg Pike (Rt. 65). Go south on Rt. 65/Sharpsburg Pike for about 3.7 miles and cross through the Rt.68 intersection.
- Continue south on Rt. 65 about another 3.3 miles to the first right turn (Bakersville Road) after the Washington County Agricultural Education Center. Bakersville Road will be on the right just 0.5 miles past the driveway entrance to this large complex and its Rural Heritage Museum.
- Go north on Bakersville Road about 1.7 miles (crossing under a railroad overpass) and take a left on Sprecher Road. (There is a Camp Mary-Mac/Merry-Mac sign at the corner.)
- As soon as you turn left, you cross a small creek; stay on Sprecher Road about 0.4 miles to the intersection of Sprecher Road and Houser Road.
- **If checking-in for a camp**, bear right at the fork to stay on Sprecher Road to the main entrance of Camp Mary-Mac.
- **If attending the Corn Roast**, bear left at the fork to turn on to Houser Road. Go about 0.5 miles to the secondary entrance to Camp Mary-Mac (along side of a Farm House and Horse Pen). There is a sign at this entrance also.

THIS IS A VERY SCENIC, BUT MORE COMPLICATED ROUTE TO CAMP MARY MAC NOT RECOMMENDED FOR NIGHT-TIME OR YOUTH-DRIVER TRAVEL

FROM THE NORTHERN AND WESTERN VA AREAS

From the Dulles Toll Road's Greenway Extension (past Dulles Airport) or from Tysons Corner area, take the Route 7 Westbound.

- Follow Rt. 7 west past Leesburg, VA to Clarks Gap, VA and take the Rt. 9 North/Westbound Exit (Charles Town Pike) towards Harpers Ferry, WV.
- Follow Rt. 9 north/west to Mechanicsville, VA and take the Rt. 671 Northbound Exit (Harpers Ferry Rd) towards Harpers Ferry, WV and the Potomac River.
- From Rt. 671, just before the Potomac River, take a left on Rt. 340 Westbound (Jefferson Pike) and follow Rt. 340 through the Harpers Ferry National Park and town of Harpers Ferry. (In town, Rt. 340 may be called Venezuela Ave.)
- A mile or two outside of town, turn right from Rt. 340 west on to Rt. 230 Northbound (Halltown Rd.). Remain in Rt. 230 north for several miles into Shepherdstown, WV. In town, Rt. 230 becomes East Washington Street. Once over the train tracks, turn right on to North Princess Street east to stay on Rt. 230. Continue north on North Princess St and then take a left on East German Street and then a few blocks later take a right on to Rt. 480 Northbound (North Duke Street). Stay on Rt. 480 north past Rt. 5, and then over the Potomac River into Maryland.
- As it crosses the River, WV Rt. 480 (N. Duke St) becomes MD Rt. 34 (Shepherdstown Pike) going towards Sharpsburg, MD and the Antietam National Battlefield. Stay on Rt. 34 for several miles into Sharpsburg, MD, where it becomes West and then East Main Street.
- From East Main Street (Rt. 34) in Sharpsburg, turn left on to Rt. 65 Northbound (North Church Street) in the center of town. Rt. 65 becomes Sharpsburg Pike as it goes north along the edge of the Antietam National Battlefield.
- From Rt. 65 (Sharpsburg Pike), after the Battlefield and after Taylors Landing Road, take a left on Bakersville Road.
- Travel one mile on Bakersville Road and turn right on to Sprecher Road.
- As soon as you turn left, you cross a small creek; stay on Sprecher Road about 0.4 miles to the intersection of Sprecher Road and Houser Road.
- **If checking in for a camp**, bear right to stay on Sprecher Road to the main entrance of Camp Mary-Mac.
- **If attending the Corn Roast**, bear left on to Houser Road for about 0.5 miles to the secondary entrance to Camp Mary-Mac (along side of a Farm House and Horse Pen). There is a sign at this entrance also.
